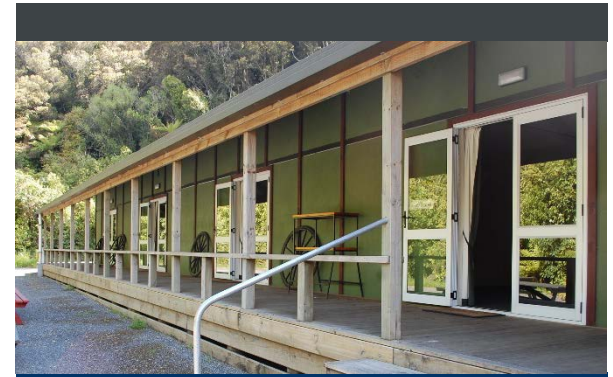
All our Marsden Valley Education Centre LEOTC programmes integrate Values identified by the current curriculum and Te Whariki.

MVEC overnight camps are provided only to schools that have booked an education programme and agreed specific Achievement Objectives and Learning Outcomes with the Educators.

All visits are for one night only and will run from 12 noon to 12 noon or from 5:00p.m to 5.00pm the following day.

Shantytown provides basic accommodation in the Conference Centre (Welshman's, 4 rooms). Bring all your own bedding. One shower is available .

Schools will have access to the kitchen area for food preparation and washing up after the cafe has closed for the day and before 8:00 a.m. the following morning. Meals can be provided for students if required at additional cost. A small barbeque is also available on request.

The only buildings available after opening hours will be the Conference Centre and Cafe. All other areas will be locked and alarmed.

The Main Gates will be closed at the end of the working day but not locked so access is available in the event of an emergency.

Students are the sole responsibility of the visiting school staff overnight. A list of emergency numbers will be provided should the need arise for help during this period.
